Lancaster County builder elected president of local builders association

EPHRATA, Pa. – Rick Martin, president of Wheatland Custom Homes, has been elected president of the Building Industry Association of Lancaster County (BIA) for 2009. Martin was officially installed at a BIA banquet held at Clipper Magazine Stadium in Lancaster on January 8.
